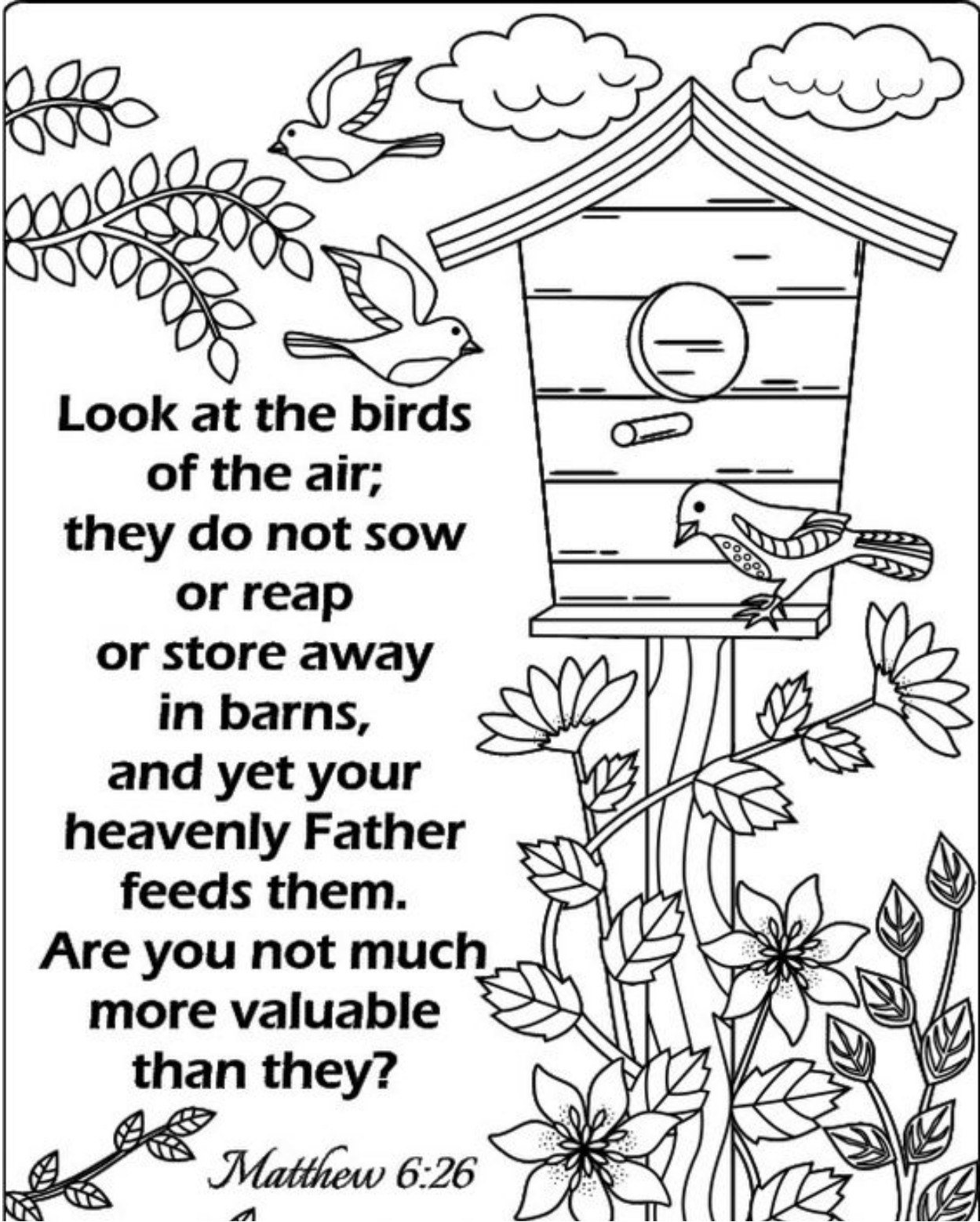


Questions to ask your kids:
