For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

- Read Hebrews 13:1-2. What is a stranger? What does it mean to be hospitable or friendly to strangers?

Tuesday:

- Read 1 Timothy 3:2. Why do you think that being hospitable is an important qualification for being an “overseer” or elder in the church?

Wednesday:

- Why do you think it is sometimes difficult to take the risk of reaching out to someone outside your circle of friends? Can you think of a time when you were glad someone reached out to you?

Thursday:

- In light of Hebrews 13:2, specifically how can you be more hospitable or friendly to strangers?

Friday:

- If all of us at Moon Valley were to become more friendly, what difference would it make?
