For Reflection & Application:

Monday

Read Romans 6:11. What does it mean to “consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus”? If our new position as believers is in reality dead to sin and alive to God, why do we need to keep considering this truth?

Tuesday

Read Romans 6:3-10. From these verses, list the things that are true about the position of believers in Christ.

Wednesday

Read Romans 6:12-13. List all the commands you can find in these verses, expressed or implied. How are they all related to one another? And how are they related to the command in 6:11 to “consider.”

Thursday

In Romans 6:13, what does it mean to present yourself to God? Specifically, how can you present yourself to God today?

Friday

What are some things that discourage you from presenting yourself to God? Are they in some way related to your perception of your position in Christ? How may feelings of shame, powerlessness, fear, and rejection play a role?
