Big Idea:

For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

Read Mark 8:27-30. Put yourselves in the shoes of the disciples or the witnesses of Jesus' miracles. Why do you think some were unconvinced of Jesus being the messiah?

Tuesday:

What is *your* response to Jesus' question, "Who do you say I am?"

Wednesday:

Think about other relationships in your life. How often do you take a step back and *define the relationship*? Are they where you want them to be?

Thursday:

Think about what your response was when you first heard that Jesus loved you. What is your response now compared to then?

Friday:

In light of now "having the whole picture" when it comes to Jesus work on the cross, why do you think people still have a hard time answering the question, "Who do you say that I am?"
